

Canvas Cleaner

Technical Data Sheet

Applications:

Canvas Cleaner is specifically developed for cleaning canvas, cotton, linen, etc surfaces. Atmospheric pollution penetrates the fibres of the canvas and also forms a breeding ground in which algae and mould can grow.

Canvas Cleaner loosens the contamination deep in the pores without damaging the surface. The product leaves no residue, as often happens when using ordinary soaps. After cleaning, the surface can be perfectly preserved using Waterproofing.

Instructions for use:

1. Protect surfaces that cannot be treated.
2. First clean the surface to be treated with clean water and a firm soft brush.
3. Dilute Canvas Cleaner in a ratio of 1:10 using clean water.
4. Then apply the product to the surface to be treated and distribute it with a brush so the entire surface is covered.
5. Then allow the product to act for approximately 10 - 20 minutes (determine by experiment).
6. Now thoroughly rinse the surface with clean water and use the brush if necessary. **Rinse thoroughly.**

Product usage:

Light to moderate soiling	Approx 100 m2 per litre
Moderate to heavy soiling	Approx 90 m2 per litre
Heavy soiling	Approx 80 m2 per litre

The above usage is indicative and should be determined by first applying to a small test area.

Considerations during application:

Always place a reference test on the to be treated surfaces in order to determine both adhesion and the technical and aesthetic result.
