Applications:

It removes all kinds of dirt easily, leaving a spot and streak-free finish. Safe for polyester, teak, plastic, metals such as chrome, stainless steel and aluminium, as well as painted surfaces. Does not affect the wax layer. Perfectly suited for use in a maintenance programme.

Instructions for use:

- 1. Protect surfaces that cannot be treated.
- Add a small amount of Hull Cleaner (a cap) to clean water in, for instance, a bucket.
- Then apply Hull Cleaner using a soft brush or sponge and allow to act for up to 10 minutes.
- 4. Always rinse the surface thoroughly with abundant clean water.
- 5. Repeat the treatment where necessary.
