Technical Data Sheet

Applications:

Waterproofing is a high-quality impregnating agent developed using the most innovative technologies. It is used to waterproof all kinds of textile fabrics. Offers long-term protection from weathering and adhesion of dirt. Does not affect the fabric and leaves a spot and streak-free finish. Ideal for use on sails, vinyl, boat cushions, boat covers, sprayhoods and sail covers.

Instructions for use:

1. Always shake the bottle before use.
2. Make sure that the surface to be treated is clean and dry; for instance, by using Canvas Cleaner or, in the case of dead mould and/or weathering stains, Stain Remover.
3. Then allow the surface to dry completely.
4. Apply Waterproofing with a pressure sprayer or large-drop sprayer in such a manner that the surface becomes fully saturated.
5. Multiple treatments may be required for heavily porous surfaces.
6. Ensure that the surface is protected against the effects of moisture for at least 2 hours.
7. The surface must be completely dry before it is loaded.

Product usage:

Depending on the porosity of the substrate, the theoretical yield is in average 3-5 m² p/ ltr.

The above usage is indicative and should be determined by first applying to a small test area.

Considerations during application:

Always place a reference test on the to be treated surfaces in order to determine both adhesion and the technical and aesthetic result.
